**Place:** Eaglewood Red Course, Langley Air Force Base

**Time:** 1:00 PM – Modified Shotgun Start

**Cost:** \$50.00 per player (\$200.00 per team) to cover greens fee, cart, practice balls and tournament prizes.

**Format:** Captains choice with teams of four players (everyone hits a shot, the Captain picks the one for the team to use and everyone plays the next shot from that point). **At least one tee shot from every player must be used during the round.** Mulligan tickets will be sold (they directly support the Scholarship Fund) for use on any shot (except closest to the pin, or long drive prizes). A mulligan used for the Larry Green Shot would be an especially strong candidate for the award. Teams will be flighted by total team handicap or estimated average scores.

**Prizes:** Lowest team scores; individual closest to the pin (par 3's); long drive on par 5 TBD; and the Larry Green Memorial Shot of the Day; the last place team will actually receive a useful prize- a one hour clinic with golf pro Hugh Hamilton!

**Food:** Prior to the round, a free hot dog and after the round, Bar-B-Que supper during awards presentation. You will receive a "ticket" when you register and in addition to the food you will receive a 10-percent discount on any item purchased that day in the pro shop.

**Beverages:** On your own but available on the course - they deliver!  
(Please don't bring your own cooler on the course)  
After: Round of drinks (two for the winners) on the AIAA and a cash bar for the rest.
